DJ	Subs and Membership DJ advised that we have 106 members. 25 having joined since October. Fees will be the same this year and will be due as of now! Explained why we need to do this. April to April is now the club year. George brought up the issue of membership cards. Club cards are on the way and Tri sports are aware of the membership. RM talked about insurance and explained that it is third party. GG talked about youth insurance and the free BC bronze membership.

	The floor questioned the demand for grass, GG advised that there was a lot of interest from other clubs and it is ideal off road activity for youth as well as an adult branch of the sport.	
	Time line was estimated at probably by May 2011, maybe by end of 2010. Planning is 4-6 months.	
	JB emphasized that we can only spend the money when we have it.	
	Committee will come back the the club by the stage of lease signing.	
	The floor was asked to vote the above in. Unanimous support was received.	
ML	Website ML was looking at ways of enhancing the website without incurring costs, wants to keep it simple.	
TD	GG wants the forum to be used more and ML wants all results to put on website. Time trial If under 18 a form of consent needs filling in, otherwise all set ready to go just need riders.	
RM	Youth section RM talked of program of events, Thursday on the rec., road rides in Stevenage, and mountain biking.	
TS	Kit TS outlined problems with kit from Bioracer. Explained that several companies were approached and why we are now using Endura. TS would like to see more riders in the blue on club runs.	
TR	Racing TR talked of the 4 or 5 regular racers and encouraged the filing of race reports. TR introduced and explained the format for the Primavera road races and encouraged participation in the 4 th cat race. More marshals needed.
